

MID Mentoring Overview

- The Intermountain District Ministerial Development Board requires a 12-month mentoring component.
- An MID may request a district mentor once the Supervised Ministry Experience component has been completed.
- The mentor assignment is made by the Ministerial Development Board Mentoring Coordinator once the MID has submitted a request for a district mentor.
- The MID meets with the assigned mentor on at least 10 occasions over a 12-month period.
- The mentoring relationship is designed to connect the MID with someone outside his or her immediate assigned ministry setting who can engage the MID in reflecting on his or her current ministry experience, sharpen ministry skills, and enhance spiritual and personal growth and awareness.
