MORTGAGE BURNING CELEBRATION

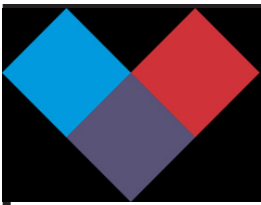
On April 12, 1988, my wife Robin, our three daughters, and I arrived in Homedale to pastor the Homedale Church of the Nazarene. The Church was in "mission" status and worshiped in a 6,000 square foot facility on 2nd and Owyhee. The congregation, we found, was a wonderful group of people that we fell in love with! It wasn't long until we began to grow in number. By 1996 we had outgrown our existing church facility. With great faith in God and hard work we began the journey of planning and raising money with the vision of building a new church facility. Over the next seven years we purchased 8.8 acres and constructed a 18,600 square foot building that included a sanctuary that had fixed seating for 400 people, nu-

merous class rooms, fellowship hall and kitchen, and a large youth center. We moved into our new facility in February of 2003. The next 16 years we finished developing the grounds and internal furnishings. We also worked to pay off the existing loan. As of December 31, 2018, we are excited to announce we are debt free!!! Praise the Lord!

We celebrated "Burn the Mortgage" on Sunday, January 27, 2019, at 10:30 a.m. We retraced Mountain View's "Faith Journey" and praised God for His power and faithfulness.

Presses are rolling on the registrations for Summer Camps sponsored by Intermountain District. **Early bird registration deadline is April 15.** Making sure you have registered your camper by this date will help save money on the cost for camp. **NEW POLICY IN 2019:** There is a second deadline set for each camp to ensure appropriate staffing, supplies, and to make sure it is a positive and safe camping experience. Please note: Walk-on registrations will not be accepted.

Final camp registration deadlines are as follows:

- June 1: Genesis Girls & Boys Camps and Senior High
- June 15: 4th – 6th Grade Boys and Girls Camps
- July 1: Middle School Camp (formerly, Junior High Camp)

The District Camps Board will offer bus transportation to and from the Treasure Valley for all campers attending 4th grade and above camps. Cost for the bus will be \$30.00/camper (round trip or one-way). Information about bus transportation will be mailed closer to the start of the season.
